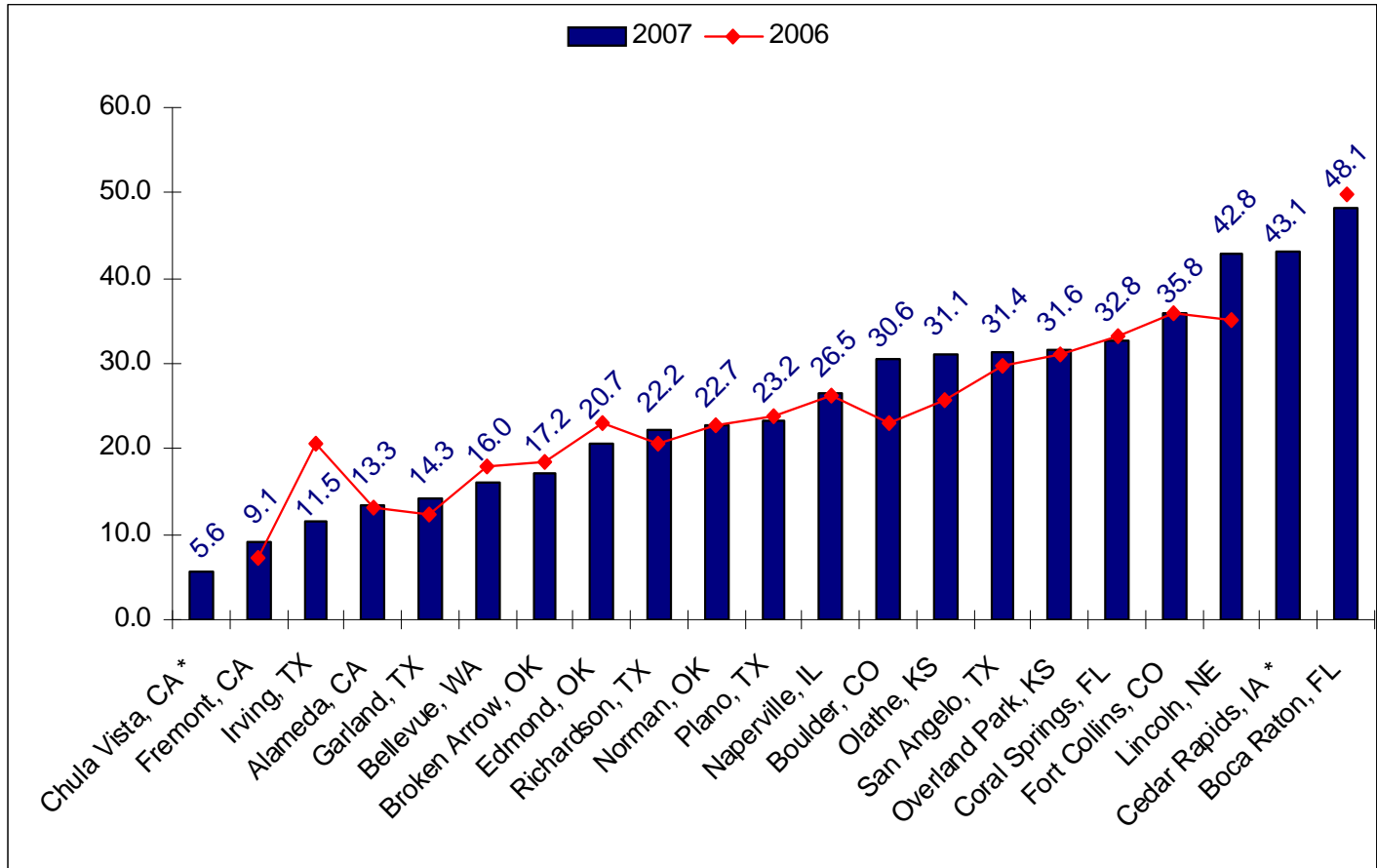

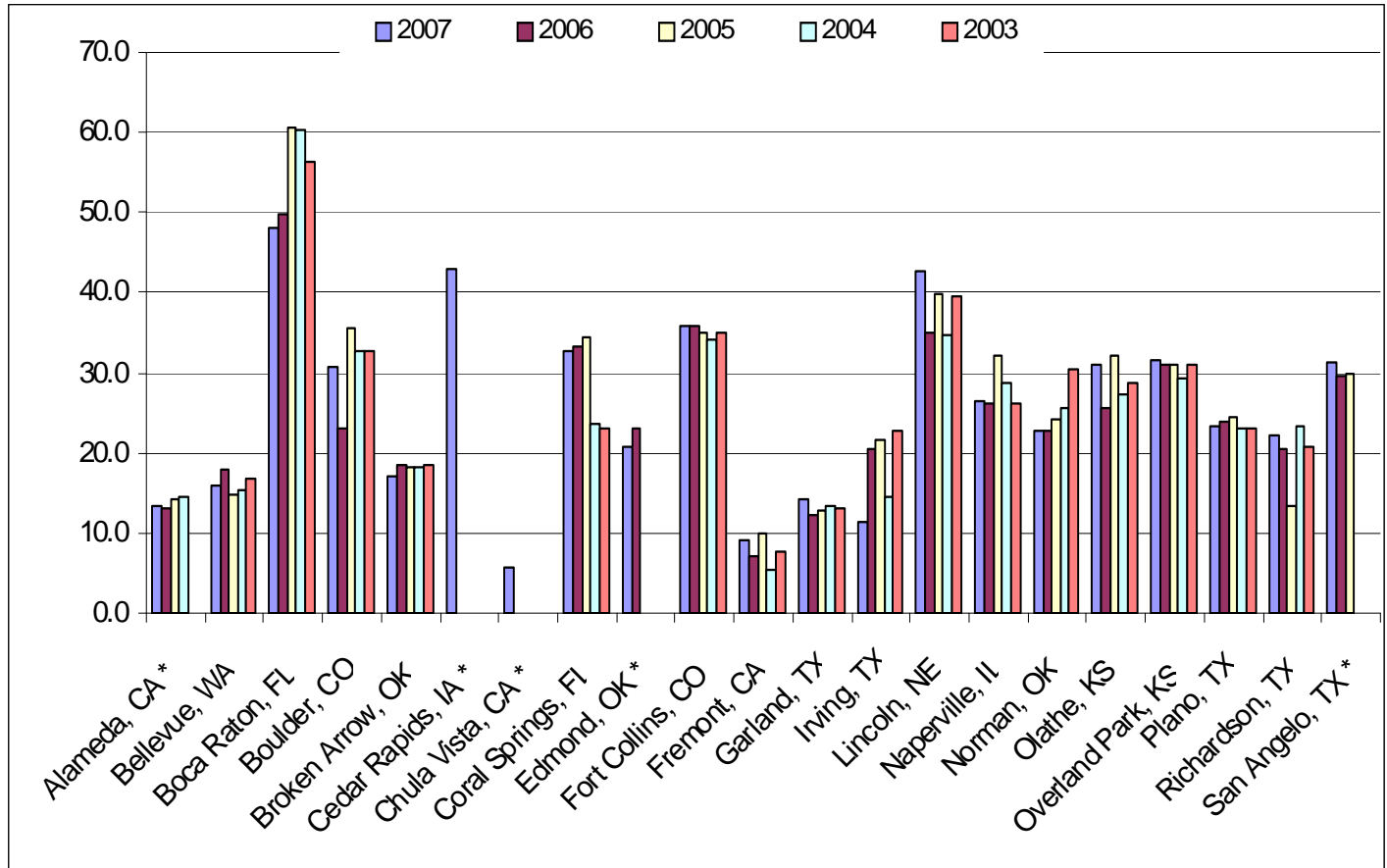

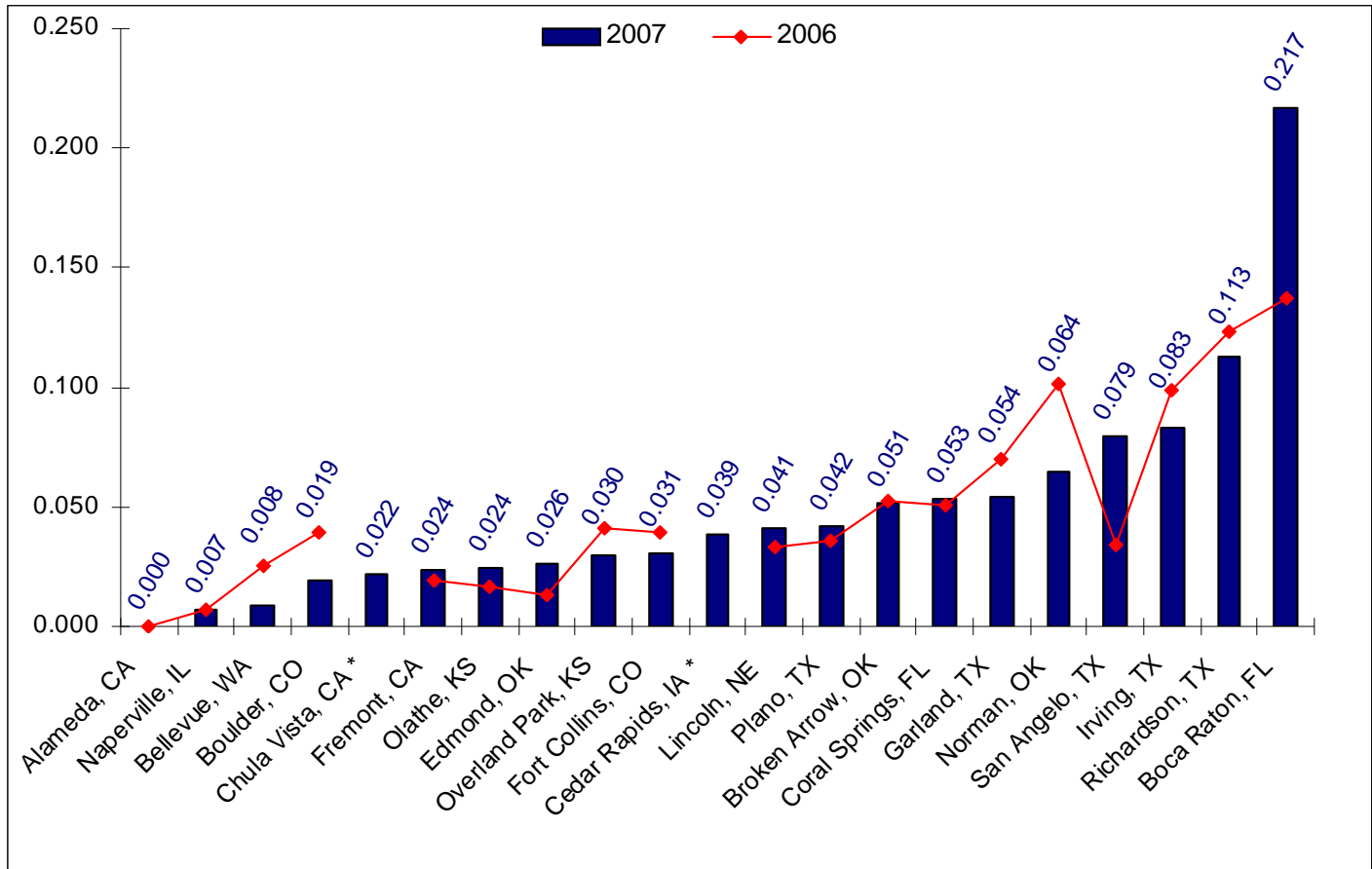

**2007 average fatality traffic crashes per 1,000 citizens is .046**

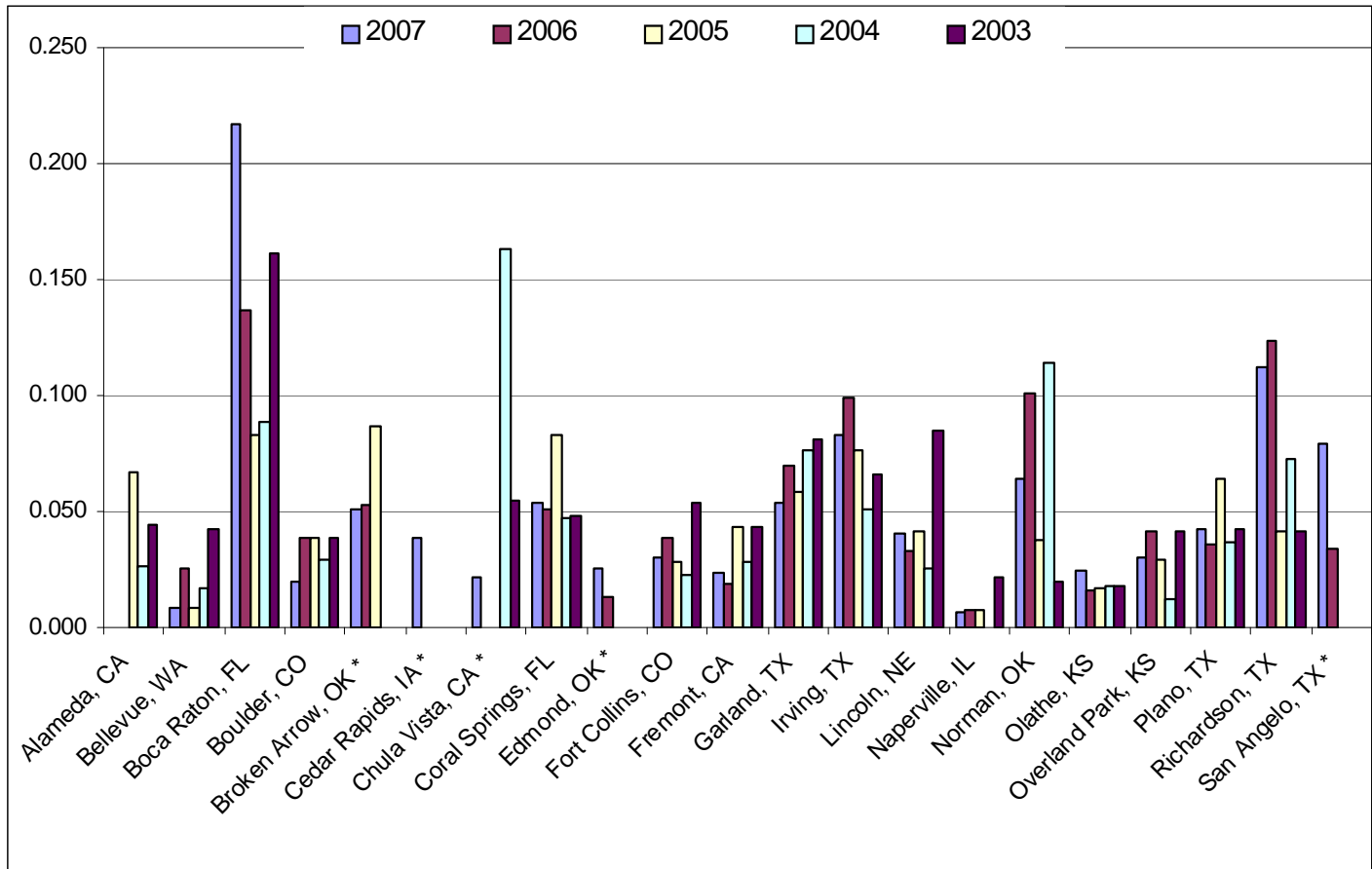

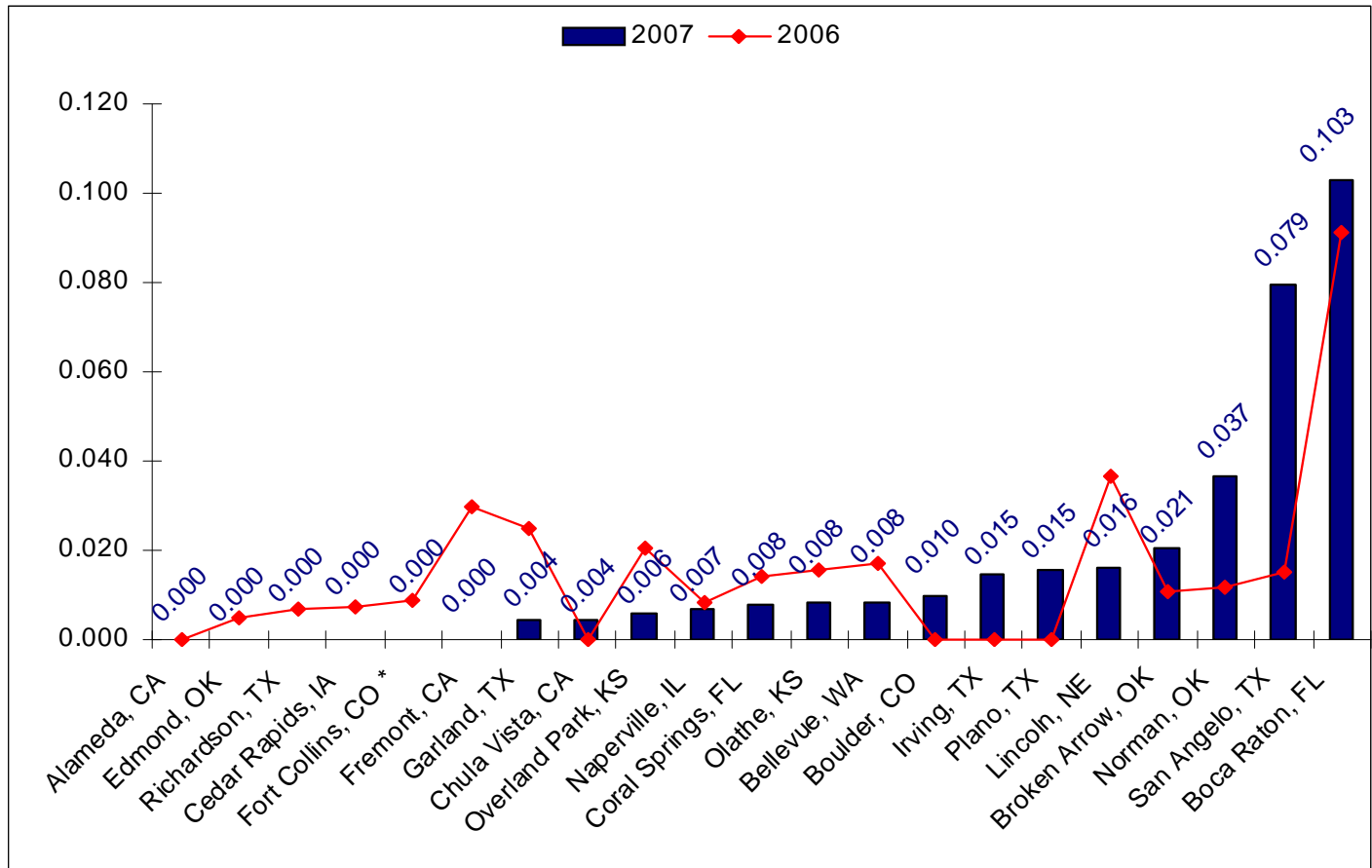
